

Update on the COVID-19 situation March 17, 2020

Dear Parents and Staff,

I have been in communication with school administrators on the process of picking up students' belongings. Each school has posted this valuable information on their individual Facebook pages, which you can access <u>here</u>. School materials are not to be returned at this time and can continue to be used to assist children with their learning. Parents will be contacted regarding the return of these materials at a later date when we return to a more normal mode of operation.

PRSD instuctional staff are working together with school administrators who, in turn, are collaborating with our Instructional Leadership team to develop a divisional approach to continued instruction that will be aligned with the rest of the province.

I posed the following question to administrators yesterday, "How do you see your school maintaining instruction now that classes have been cancelled?" This valuable information will be collected and analyzed on Wednesday, March 18, 2020, when we meet online with school administrators.
